

## SECOND PLANNING MEETING WITH PARISH

December 9, 2012 St Johns basement

Committee members: St Johns women: Dorothy Vershure, Dawn Holland, Elaine Emery , Dee Hone and Rose Wendell (worker contact). Building: Karen Pinkerton. Finance: Brenda Oster. Meals on Wheels: Laurie Arthur and Monica Whiting. Knights of Columbus: John Fejifar.

Dorothy and Dawn presented the most recent plans and layout for cabinets in the kitchen. Two bids have been given: Do It Best, Custer and Knechts, Rapid City. The cabinet door style was shared, color and wood choice. Prices being reviewed are for the maple finish. Examples of counter top were passed out. To date the plans are to use mostly pullouts and drawers. The middle counter tops will be elevated and the other counters will remain the current height. The upper cabinets holding the cups and glasses will not be replaced but new doors will be purchased and the outside of the cabinets will be painted a matching color. The floor in the kitchen will be recommended for replacement. The committee recommended placing the refrigerators in the kitchen to the right of the stove. The current refrigerator space would be used for shelving.

There was discussion of using the small room off the kitchen for the dishwasher. John Fejifar has concerns about the limited space available in this room. John was provided a printout of various stainless steel options available for sinks and counters.

Dawn and Dorothy met with the State Health Department. We do not need three sinks. We need a large sink by the dishwasher, a hand washing sink near the dishwashing area and a food prep sink in the kitchen.

The committee is to see if full extension drawers are included in the plans.

All women were encouraged to look at the Lutheran Church kitchen layout.

John Fejifar will meet with the Knights of Columbus and ask if the men were willing to tear out and install the new cabinets and coordinate any electric or plumbing projects

The committee will ask the council if we could list items we plan to purchase for the kitchen remodel project in the bulletin and allow for parishioners to buy a specific item.

No date was set for a follow-up discussion. The committee will continue to work on the design and price out the cabinet options. We will continue to solicit ideas and recommendations from the Knights of Columbus. By the end of December we hope to hear from the Diocese Grant Proposal that was submitted.

**ADDENDUM TO MEETING:** Committee members are meeting with the furnace and insurance representatives in the near future. John was hoping part of the furnace room

could be partitioned off and used for the dishwasher. This would provide more room for dishwashing. If this occurred, layout of cabinets would need to be reviewed.

Follow-up: We were told that this was not a possibility. They need the space for working on the furnace and need for two doors in furnace room.
