### President's Report / New Business:

From the recent Parish Council meeting, Janet reported the following: future Parish Work Day; a parishioner has donated \$5,000 toward concrete replacement at the front of the church; new boiler is fully functional; Fr. Tim wants one Sunday bulletin encompassing all 3 parishes with the business ads on a rotation basis; Ed Fischer is in charge of the Lay ministers; Mary Eide will retire on January 25th; the parish will hire a part-time secretary/bookkeeper for 4 hours/day - 5 days per week; Joan from Hot Springs will no longer be in the office on Thursdays. All other tasks will be covered on a volunteer basis – including the front desk.

Janet read a note from Fr. Pete thanking the women's group for the gift.

Annual Membership Dues of \$2.00 currently due – a collection was made.

### Old Business:

**Kitchen Remodel** - Our Diocesan Grant request for \$50,000 was denied – those approved were for \$10,000.

The Custer Ministerial Alliance/Round Table will pay for the cost of enlarging the doorway into the Resource Room for use by the Senior Meals Program and for any electrical changes. Another consideration would be to enlarge the doorway to the Ladies room, reduce to one stall and add a changing table. It was noted that there is a changing table in the unisex restroom upstairs. Will consult with Karen Pinkerton of the parish Building Committee. The Ministerial Alliance group will be attending the Senior Meals on February 5th – additional volunteers for this day would be helpful. Dawn Holland has again consulted with Do It Best and Knecht in regards to cabinet layout/costs.

### New Business:

**Annual Ham Dinner** – Elain Emery motioned that the Ham Dinner be held on **March 17**; the motion was seconded by Patty Wagner and approved by all present. Janet offered to do the sign-up board. Patty Wagner mentioned she would be available to help with the dinner plans until Feb. 19th.

Monica Whiting reported that Dee Hone has taken over her post of handling Bingo at the Nursing Home on a Bi-monthly basis. The next Bingo is scheduled for March 8th at 2:00pm (2nd Friday).

The meeting was adjourned and closed with prayer at 7:25pm and immediately followed with our annual Napkin Exchange. Next meeting is scheduled for Sunday, February 10th.
