Meetings to receive parish input on the Initial Design Concept are planned for March 8/9 and 15/16 after Mass. Formal approval from the diocese will be requested after input from parishioners is received and Father Collins has approved the plans. If everything proceeds as planned, construction is expected to begin in September 2025 with completion in May 2026. All dates are tentative.
